<u>Homeowners Association Lawn Maintenance Responsibilities</u>

The day-to-day operation for the lawn care is handled by **Chris Sherron of Sherron Landscaping**. His contract includes:

- 1. Lawns will be cut as often as necessary to maintain a neat and uniform appearance of 3 to 4 inches. Variance may occur in drought, high temperatures or excessive rain. Grass clippings will not be allowed to accumulate.
- 2. Edge all sidewalks, curbs, and driveways.
- 3. Weeding will be done to maintain a neat and weed free appearance in all natural areas, walkways, and paved areas.
- 4. Pruning of shrubbery and ornamental trees will be done at the appropriate time of the year, as needed. Clippings and dead branches will be removed.
- 5. Leaf Removal from all lawns, walkways, and parking areas in the fall of each year.
- 6. Trash and Debris will be picked up on a weekly basis.
- 7. Pine straw application will be done once each year. You should expect this in January or February, depending on the weather and availability of the straw.
- 8. Ornamental shrubbery treated insect control.
- 9. Lawns fertilized and treated for weeds four (4) times per year.
- 10. Lawns aerated and seeded annually. (September October)
- 11. Gutters are cleaned twice annually by <u>Southern Outdoor Restoration</u>. As a normal rule, you can expect this service soon after the pollen stops falling in the spring (April-May) and in the late fall (November), when many of the leaves have fallen.
